On August 14 - 16, 2006, an international symposium on the design of healthcare facilities for Africa will take place in Pretoria (South Africa). Organised with the support of the South African Institute of Architects and the South African Department of Health, the symposium's theme is *Designing for Sustainable Healthcare Facilities in Africa: global sharing, local relevance and impact*.

Aims of the symposium:

- . develop a network for health facility architects and design professionals in Africa
- . improve understanding of the importance and challenges of health facility design through sharing experiences, learning, and design innovations
- . identify specific and common issues impacting the design and delivery of health facilities in Africa and developing countries
- . identify ways through which relevant research can be identified and supported
- . identify ways in which mutual support can be provided towards the improvement of health facilities.

MILOS WORKSHOP

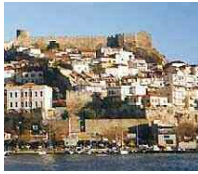
