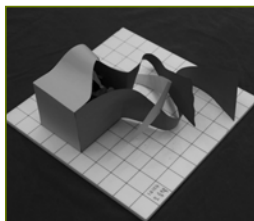

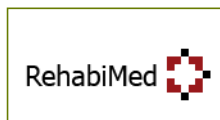
ARCHITECTURE ON THE BIG SCREEN
