### THE UIA SIGNS AN AGREEMENT WITH ITS SPANISH SECTION FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF AN INTERNATIONAL SYSTEM OF CONTINUING EDUCATION

Immediately following its **107th Council session** in Xian, PR of China, on 10 to 12 October 2007, UIA President **Gaetan Siew** signed, on behalf of the Union, an accord with the **Superior Council of Associations of Spanish Architects - CSCAE** for the implementation of an international programme of continuing professional development.

The agreement was

co-signed by **Carlos Hernandez Pezzi**, CSCAE President, on 16 October.

This accord stipulates that the **CSCAE** will be responsible for **setting up and managing the UIA continuing professional development programme**, through a service company created for this purpose and defined as the programme **operator**.

## ITALY

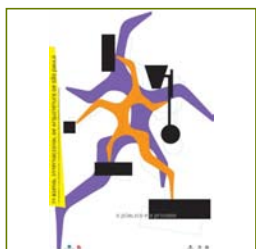
**BARBARA CAPPOCHIN ARCHITECTURE BIENNIAL**

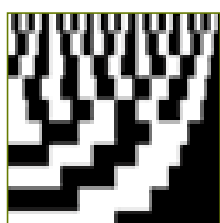
