
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"ARCHITECTURE IN SCHOOLS" PROGRAM 2012-2013 (4th Grade) & 2013-2014 (5th Grade)

In continuation to a pilot/education program ran by a group of volunteer architects, initiated as a parallel event to the 11th Panhellenic Architectural Congress held in Athens in 2011, organized by SADAS-PEA (Association of University Graduated Architects-Panhellenic Union of Architects), the H.A.E.F.-Athens College Elementary School introduced the "Architecture in Schools" Program within its educational system. Implemented programs, so far, range from 3rd to 6th grade (ages 8-12) within the curriculum, incorporated within the lessons such as art, history, computers or environmental study or as an extracurricular activity.

The general educational objective of participating in the program is to introduce to children subjects relating to perception of the built environment, observation and awareness of scale (human, buildings, neighborhoods, cities), knowledge of the history of architecture and the value of architectural heritage, familiarization with materials and construction capabilities, building techniques, concepts of architectural form, technology and interactive relationship with the environment both natural and manmade, thus increasing their understanding of architecture, support their understandingofsocial, economicandecological sustainability, encourage sensitivity, creativity and critical thinking. The specific program was organized in 2 phases, in 2 consecutive school years, addressed to the same kids (see attached analytical program).

The first phase (12 sessions), within the arts lesson, included presentations and lectures on traditional and contemporary architecture, architecture and environment, landscape architecture etc, as well as a presentation/ discussion about scale, floorplans, elevations, sections. Workshop activities included sketching, drawing (in scale), expressing/designing their own idea for a building that they would later construct as a model with a predefined kit of materials (wooden cubes 3x3x3cm, cardboards, twigs etc), presenting and discussing their project and concluded with an exhibition of their work.

The second phase (6 sessions), within the computers lesson, included a slideshow/quiz on contemporary architecture (Mies van der Rohe Awards 2013) where the kids became the jurors, thus stimulating their critical ability, as well as lessons on the use of the "sweet home" CAD program, which they used (as a different/new means of expression) in designing their own architectural idea.

The aforementioned program aimed towards a more intergraded multifaceted approach.


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
