Ref.: Support for the determination of professional rights of architects in Greece

Dear President Dimitris Xynomilakis,

the National Council of Architects, Planners, Landscapers and Conservatories of Italy represents the 105 Territorial Chambers and the 154.000 Italian Architects. It aims, among others, to promote the social role of Architecture and to "make cities and human settlements inclusive, safe, resilient and sustainable", according to the principles of the 2030 UN Urban Agenda.

The National Council of Italy, wants to express its support to the Greek Association SADAS PEA, in its aim to ensure that the profession, and also society are safeguarded following the introduction of new legislation in the country. The architectural projects, with particular reference to the works concerning both the existing and the actual projects, should be executed and signed by qualified architects;

- both as regards interventions in protected areas with historical interest, or subject to particular landscape constraints, in areas where particular conservation conditions are applied, both to individual buildings and to the built environment;
- both for what concerns the planimetric design for the approval of a project, as well as for the stipulation of contracts or cadastral works, because, they have an academic background able to satisfy these needs.

Finally, we would like to invite national and local governments to work in collaboration with the official representatives of architects, such as SADAS-PEA in Greece, and other international representative bodies such as the Architects Council of Europe (ACE), to find adequate solutions regarding professional rights, in particular when the work and theme of the projects contain historical, morphological, archaeological and landscape elements.
